Development of forest and culture

Tree planting for the future generations

Healthy nature growing healthy trees is the foundation of our business. It is our standard to reduce the burden on the environment and to protect the health of customers. The total number of oak trees we've planted so far amounts to 50000. CondeHouse has been planting trees for over 20 years, and will continue to do that for the future generations.

Proper use of forest resources

Illegal logging has been long said to cause deforestation. CondeHouse uses logs certified by PEFC (the Programme for the Endorsement of Forest Certification) and FSC (Forest Stewardship Council), and is registered as a wood-related business entity of the Clean Wood Act. We always make full use of wood to the last small piece and produce safe and long-life furniture.

Active use of local wood

Furniture manufacturers in Hokkaido have expanded the usage of Hokkaido wood. CondeHouse has been using locally grown trees on its products, and the ratio of Hokkaido wood in our furniture production will soon exceed 60%. We believe this action will contribute to the reduction of carbon emissions by transportation.

Environmental load reduction

In order to keep pace with the environmental protection actions across the world, the green procurement law was established in 2000. The Japanese government has tried to support the development of eco-friendly society through obligating public agencies to procure eco-friendly products. Green Purchasing Network is an organization consisting of endorsing companies for the government program, and CondeHouse has joined as one of the members.

Wood

The features of wood

Every single tree from the forest has its own natural marks. The heartwood and sapwood almost never share the same color, and no wood shares the same trait. Here at CondeHouse, we utilize such marks given from the nature to make pieces of furniture look more beautiful.

Reliable and safe products

VOC (volatile organic compounds) emission and its human impact have become a big social problem, and the Japanese government has established laws and standards to regulate VOC. CondeHouse carefully chooses plywood, gules, etc. according to the government regulations.



























About CondeHouse Products

Wood finish

Our wood coating is prepared to be transparent to emphasize the natural grain and color of wood. The color portfolio is unified to each wood so that our items from different collections can be coordinated for various styles of rooms.



About 80 kinds of fabrics and leathers are available for chairs and sofas, and they regularly change according to the times and trends.

Chair height customization

Seat height is very important. You cannot feel comfortable with a chair with inappropriate seat height. We cut chair legs according to customers' requests. Additionally, we response to other diverse requests such as cutting table legs, changing table top size, etc.





Water repellent finish

Pearl Tone (TM) is a water-repellent finish, often used for Japanese kimono. Now, it is evolved to Pearl Tone (HG) for furniture upholstery, stain-proof in addition to improving water-repellence, but makes almost no change in the texture of upholstery fabric.

Restoration

Repair

In order to keep sustainability of the wood industry, it's important to use wood at the same rate of tree growth. We re-upholster or re-paint trade-in furniture, and also emphasize the maintainability of our products to make repair easier.

Recycling

Trade-in and resale

Now that nearly half a century has passed since we started business, there are many customers replacing their old furniture with new ones from our lineup again. We trade-in, repair, and resell such old furniture as vintage products.







Materials



Wood

Grain

We cannot gain a lot of straightgrain part from one tree. Places where branches once grew become gnarls, and the grains of such places wave. We place these wood characters efficiently on the surface of furniture so that they look attractive.

Surrounding environmental effect

Exposed to direct sunlight or hot air from heater, wood may suffer from color change or small splinters. Even so, it makes a comeback by repair.

Color

Even though lumber boards are taken from the same wood, the color of the boards may vary for their places of the wood: outside or inside; upper or bottom.

Aging changes

Wood (especially solid wood) keeps on moving after processed into furniture. Table top boards of solid wood may warp or break. Even so, they can continue to be used by repair.

Damages

Solid wood furniture may be dented by impact or burned by heat. Even after such damages, it can continue to be used by repair: dents by steam heating; burnt places by whittling and painting.

Grain

Random match

Wood planks or veneer sheets are joined at random, of which expressive surface patterns require craftspeople for high skills and an eye for beauty.

Book match

Two pieces of wood planks or veneer sheets with similar surface patterns are arranged side by side to look like a book opened, which makes surface patterns look more dynamic by grains running symmetrically.

Slip match

The most simple but beautiful repeating surface pattern is produced by arranging in order wood planks or veneer sheets facing in the same direction. In most cases, straight grain planks or veneer sheets are preferred.





Fabric

Carefully selected materials

Cotton with dry feel, breathing linen, and regenerated fiber, rayon, well known for its beautiful glow. They are the main materials used for the upholstery of our furniture and cushions. We carefully select those materials for comfortability, design, etc. The sum of such small considerations will make a big difference.

Wide variation

Fabric collections varying in color, pattern, texture, etc. Some of them may just look simple and basic at first glance, but a closer look will show complex woven patterns, brightness, etc. By combining those fabric collections with our options of wood and its color coating, the attractiveness of our products will expand in the three styles: North noble; Simple & Natural; Advanced classic.

Leather

Bits of knowledge about leather

Hide is tanned into leather. A close look at the surface of leather shows many scars and wrinkles called natural marks. Leather can be divided into two types by surface treatment: full grain leather (RK, MG, KP, BQ and GR); corrected grain leather (EN and MR).

The seven CondeHouse leather collections are appropriately and characteristically painted or embossed for the texture and maintainability.

Paint

There are two major paints for leather: pigment and aniline. Pigment coats the surface of leather, while aniline penetrates inside. These two paints are mixed for the leather collection of CondeHouse so that texture, concealment of natural marks, and maintainability can keep a balance at a higher level.

Texture

We have embossed leather as well as natural wrinkle leather to maximize the charm of natural leather grain.

Oak is likely to have tiger stripes; especially Japanese oak is more. Other natural marks may also appear on top boards, backrests, arms, etc., which is intentionally designed for beautiful harmony.

*Japanese Birch


Japanese Birch is a tree locally grown in Hokkaido. The heartwood is red; the sapwood is white. Here at CondeHouse, we use both heartwood and sapwood. Consequently, their mixed natural colors make our furniture look unique.

Leather grade

- CL1 MR Medium-thick corrected grain leather with good maintainability by stain- and damage-proof design.
- L2 RK Painted and (large-pattern) embossed thick leather with good maintainability by stain- and damage-proof design, suitable especially for sofas.
- L3 MG Painted and embossed medium-thick and soft leather with good maintainability by stain- and damage-proof design; greyish color is available.
- L3 EN Corrected grain leather with both good maintainability by stain- and damage-proof design and good texture by light correction and fine-particle pigment.
- L3 KP Light painted leather good in texture and maintainability due to natural wrinkle finish and fine-particle pigment.
- L3 BQ Thick and soft semi-aniline leather with natural wrinkle finish—the all-round leather in our leather collection.
- L4 GR Thick and soft aniline leather with natural wrinkle finish—real natural leather without any correction.

Maintenance



How to place furniture

Place furniture as flatly as possible in order to prevent strength deterioration, breakage, and collateral damages. Don't forget to set up adjusters for furniture in case they are installed. When moving furniture, be careful not to damage paint or make dents.

Direct sunlight and heat

Direct sunlight may deteriorate the color of natural materials: wood, fabric, and leather. Heat and extreme dry conditions may warp wood.

How to maintain furniture

Wooden furniture is vulnerable to water or moisture. Wipe softly with a dry cloth and don't rub hard in order to avoid scars. When it's dirty, wipe with a squeezed wet cloth and then with a dry one. Don't use volatile liquids such as benzene, alcohol, or thinner in order to avoid color deterioration.

How to maintain fabric

Pad softly and vacuum dust coming onto the surface. When it's stained, pad softly with a cloth firmly squeezed after being soaked in a neutral detergent, wipe with a squeezed wet cloth, and finish with a dry cloth.

How to maintain leather

Wipe with a dry cloth as needed. Don't rub too hard to prevent a clog of dust in pores; don't use oil cloth to prevent stains. Vacuum-clean with a soft brush regularly.

How to maintain cushions

Padding softly and pulling into shape prevent cushions from wrinkling and losing shape.

Sawmill factory


The water content rates of wood are controlled to be appropriate as material for furniture. The rates are controlled by master craftspeople who know everything about wood. This is the beginning place for our production.

North factory

This factory is for cabinets, tables, and even detailed custom made products, where large machines are installed, so that big panels of up to 1.5 m x 3.0 m can be processed.

East factory

Master craftspeople manipulate stateof-the-art machines in our factories, where substantial synergy is provided. Every single wood is different, and therefore, each wood is processed appropriately to its characteristics.





Site area: 30,900 square meters

The head office of CondeHouse with our development, administrative and marketing divisions is located in Asahikawa, Hokkaido, next to the factories. We also maintain close ties with other factories for certain types of specialty work. Flexible and consistent production is assured through small-lot production using a system that covers every step from acquiring materials to machining, assembly, and shipping. This system also offers customers the advantage of quick turnaround on custom orders and other special orders.



Upholstery factory

A large variation of fabrics is offered for chairs and sofas, and the lineup is regularly refreshed, reflecting the international trend of interior design. In addition, leather suitable for different applications is also offered.

IPPONGI

IPPONGI was launched in 1997. At this oldest factory used since the establishment of CondeHouse, more importance is laid to traditional techniques. Only small number of selected craftsmen are deployed, and they have been making furniture with their long experience in wood working.

Restoration lab

Fortunately enough, we have many customers who want to use our products long even after the products are damaged or stained. The Restoration lab responds to such requests. Our experienced craftsmen listen to customers' requests and restore long-used furniture accordingly. Nothing pleases craftsmen more than their products are long used.








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

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
